The entry fee

This covers the cost of hiring a professional company to supply the boats, helmsmen and instructors. The other expenses (hire of venue etc.) are covered by the sponsorship of the event brochure, advertising, corporate sponsorship and the two Rotary Clubs. No charity money is used to offset any of these expenses.

Information pack

As soon as we receive your entry form and fee, we will send you an information pack. This gives you all the details you need to participate.

Last minute instructions will be given at the pre-event reception.

Personal Sponsorship

Each crew member is asked to raise a minimum of £50, so that each team raises a minimum of £1000. By using PayPal online, WHICH WE REQUEST THAT YOU DO, you do not have the trouble of collecting cash. Each team PayPal donation card will also be displayed on our website under the <u>Sponsor a Team</u> section.
